Football skills sessions have given our learners a real pride in their game – well done Alexander, that smile says it all! ★

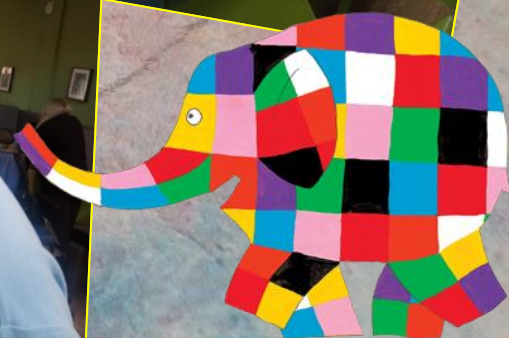
